## Online Course Details

### Access

The format will be an online educational portal, accessed via my website. Access to content is provided by a unique login username and password that can be distributed to your school's staff and students. A copyright licensing agreement will be provided to sign (stating that content will not be copied or shared beyond school).

### Year 12 Online Toolkit- Art as Knowledge & Beyond

This toolkit will have a series of short videos, documents and resource links to help students navigate their senior studies. I use my own art practice, research methods and lecturing experience as a basis to communicate content in a clear and senior-student-friendly manner. The content is designed to move through at own pace. It can be revisited when required and provide lots of imagery/ideas related to the Art as Knowledge Unit in particular (but extends into following units).

This series has been produced after initial 2020 online incursions I made in response to learning-from-home. I have refined the delivery by combining some of this existing material and breaking up video content into shorter 'bite-sized' chunks. Arts Qld funding allowed for some professional videography and web support.

### Year 11 Online Incursion- Coded Landscape

#### Video series

1. A welcome/intro video (2min)
2. Artist Talk (28min), story of my practice, drivers behind work, motives, changes & outcome. Lots of images & connections to inquiry model/how to frame & investigate a problem.
3. Breakdown of experience to abstraction/code (25min), talk & small journal activities filled with images and practical steps. Discuss poetic symbols, steps to abstraction, turning sensory experience into form, journaling/methods, and experimental approaches.
4. Practical drawing/collage video (25min)
5. Painting demonstration (15min)
